Because two more days are needed to complete building up the 50-yard berm, the AMLGC range WILL REMAIN CLOSED Monday July 31st and Tuesday August 2nd. More range news:

The Board of Directors has decided to close the 385-meter rifle target line permanently. The 200 and 300 yard target lines will be re-opened after their berms are raised similar to what has been added to the 100-yard berm. But first the 50-yard berm will be raised. The reasoning on this is that the club's 'bread and butter" is at 100 yards and shorter ranges, where most people shoot most of the time.

Black Powder Cartridge silhouette matches for the rest of 2023 are cancelled. Because the challenge is shooting at several distances, just shooting paper at 100 wouldn't present the same fun challenge. Expect BPC to resume when the 200 and 300 yard lines are open again.

There were 14 rifle shooters and 10 pistol shooters, a great turn-out!


The next two fun silhouette shoots will be on **September 17th and December 17th**. Pistol matches are also added to future 3rd-Sunday fun silhouette shoots.
